

GREEN CORRIDORS

Baltic Development Forum 2010 was held recently and the Port of Gothenburg was invited along to speak about the port and its involvement in Green Corridors, an EU initiative aimed at improving transport efficiency and reducing emissions. One of the driving forces behind this initiative is the Ministry of Enterprise, Energy and Communications and Logistics Forum.

With Stora Enso as a dynamic partner, Green Cargo, Cobelfret and the Port of Gothenburg will work to establish trailer traffic to the continent based on the Green Corridors principle. This is a European venture and includes both Swedish and continental companies and organisations.

According to Arvid Guthed, who represented the Port of Gothenburg at the Forum in Lithuania, the transport industry is facing a major challenge to reduce its emissions. "With our involvement in Green Corridors we have demonstrated concrete solutions, such as our 25 rail shuttles."
